

Sewing through the fold

Also known as Smyth sewing, is the highest quality book binding for hard cover books. It can also be used for soft cover books. Multiple pages are printed on a single sheet, which is then folded to make signatures. Smyth sewing then attaches multiple signatures together by sewing through the folds on the binding edge. The pages are physically sewn into the book using binders thread and further reinforced with fabric backing and adhesive to create the most usable and durable books available.
